

**VILLAGE OF OTTER LAKE
ORDINANCE NO. 37**

An ordinance to reduce the number of trustees to four as permitted by PA 3 of 1895, being the Michigan General Law Village Act.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Reduction of the Number of Trustees.

The number of trustees shall be reduced from six trustees to four trustees who, with the president, shall constitute the Village Council.

Section 2. Term of Office.

Two village trustees shall be elected biennially for four-year terms beginning with the November 2013 general election.

The term of office for incumbent Trustee Terry Gill shall be extended so that he and the fourth trustee shall be elected biennially for four-year terms at the November 2015 general election.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective 45 days after adoption.
