

VILLAGE OF OTTER LAKE
FIREARM DISCHARGE ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 16.1

An ordinance to prohibit the discharge of firearms within the Village limits in order to protect the public safety; to define the term "firearm"; to provide penalties for violations hereof; and to repeal the prior ordinance.

THE VILLAGE OF OTTER LAKE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Definition of firearms. For purposes of this ordinance, the term "firearm" shall include rifles, shotguns, pistols, hand guns, pellet guns, BB guns, air rifles, crossbows and any other weapon which fires a projectile with the capability of injuring human beings.

Section 2. Discharge of Firearms Prohibited. No person shall discharge any firearm within the Village limits.

Section 3. Repeal. The former Otter Lake Village firearm discharge Ordinance, adopted on November 28, 1983, is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Violations. Any violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor which shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed 90 days.

The undersigned President and Clerk of the village of Otter Lake hereby certify that this ordinance was adopted by the Otter Lake village Council at a meeting duly held on the 21st day of July 1986, and was published in the Lakeville Aerial on the 29th day of July, 1986. This ordinance was made effective 20 days after said date of adoption.
