

VILLAGE OF OTTER LAKE
PARK ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 21

An ordinance to regulate activities within the Otter Lake Village Park for the mutual benefit of the users of said park.

THE VILLAGE OF OTTER LAKE ORDAINS:

- Section 1. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. No person shall consume or possess any alcoholic beverages in the picnic area or on the bathing beach of the Otter Lake Village Park.
- Section 2. OPERATION OF BOATS. No person shall operate a motor boat at a speed or in a manner which would endanger the life or property of others.
- Section 3. CHANGING OF CLOTHES. No person shall be allowed to use private automobiles or areas open to public view for purposes of changing clothes or donning bathing suits.
- Section 4. ENTRY FEES. No person shall enter the Otter Lake Village park without first making payment to the park manager for the required entry fee.
- Section 5. IMPROPER ENTRY. No person shall enter the Otter Lake Village park by going over, under or through the fence or at any other place than the properly designated entrances to the park.
- Section 6. MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING. No person shall park a motor vehicle within the Otter Lake Village park unless the operator of the motor vehicle has paid the required fee to the park manager for use of the grounds of the public park.
- Section 7. VIOLATIONS. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance, except for the provision as to motor vehicle parking, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor which shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$500.00 Dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Violations of the motor vehicle parking requirements of this ordinance shall constitute a civil infraction and shall result in a civil penalty being paid to the Otter Lake parking violations bureau pursuant to Otter Lake Village Ordinance No.22.
- Section 8. REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCE. The former ordinance regulating the use of the park and bathing beaches of the Village of Otter Lake adopted on December 3, 1962, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- Section 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect twenty days after the date of adoption specified below.
