

VILLAGE OF OTTER LAKE  
UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE ORINANCE  
ORDINANCE NUMBER 10.3

An ordinance to adopt by reference the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Villages and Townships as authorized by Act Number 62 of the Public Acts of 1956.

THE VILLAGE OF OTTER LAKE ORDAINS:

- Section 1. Code Adopted. The Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Villages and Townships promulgated by the Director of State Police and published in the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code and amendments as published in the quarterly supplement number 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, is hereby adopted by reference.
- Section 2. References IN CODE. References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Villages and Townships to "governmental unit" shall mean the Village of Otter Lake.
- Section 3. AVAILABILITY OF CODE. The Village Clerk, after publishing this ordinance and a notice of adoption of the Uniform Traffic Code, shall keep a complete copy of the Code available at the Village office for use and inspection by the public.
- Section 4. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES APPEALED. The former Uniform Traffic Code Ordinance Number 10, 10.1 and 10.2 are hereby repealed in their entirety.
- Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Uniform Traffic Code Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its date of publication.
